

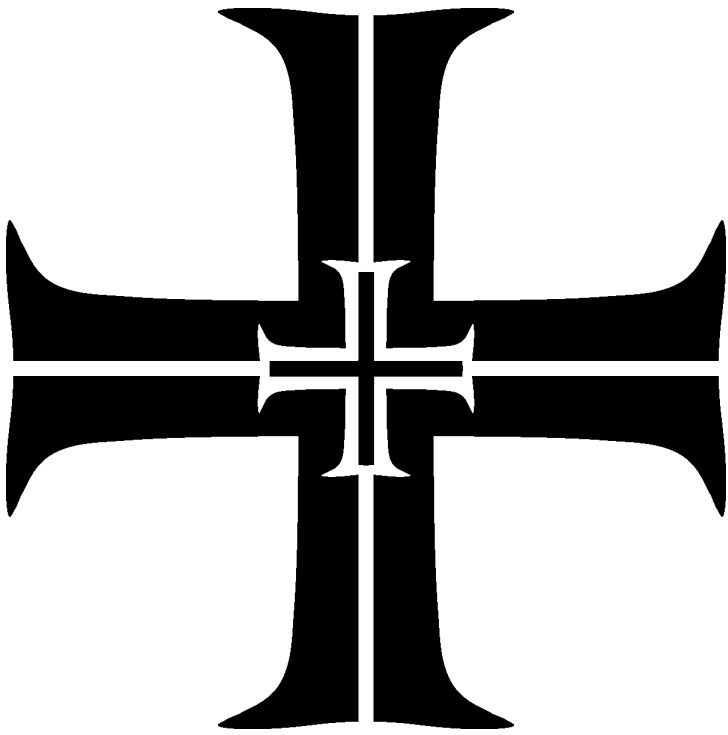

All And blessed be his kingdom, now and for ever. Amen.

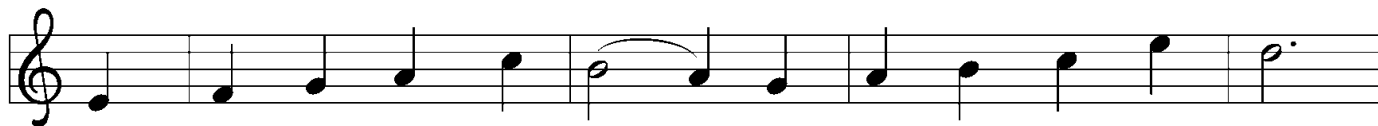
