

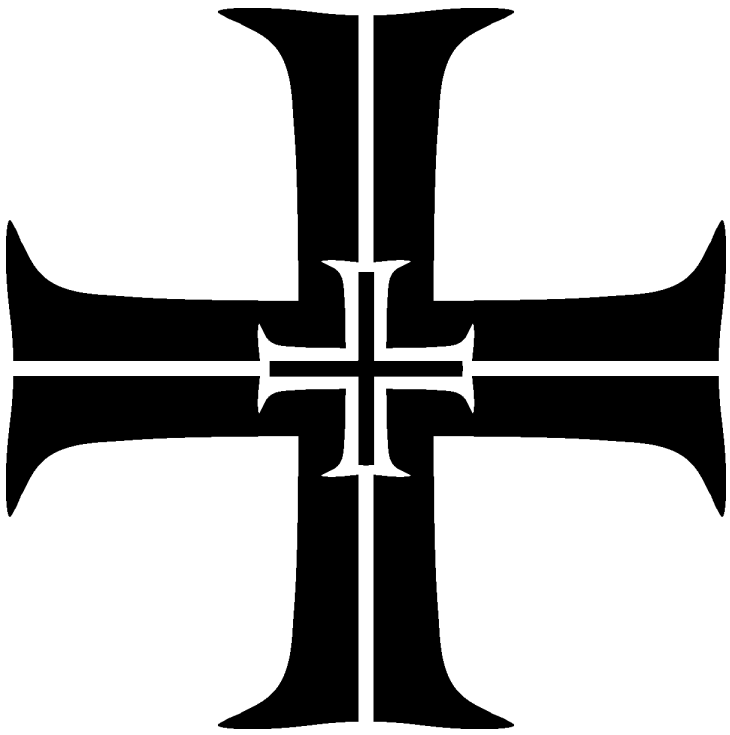

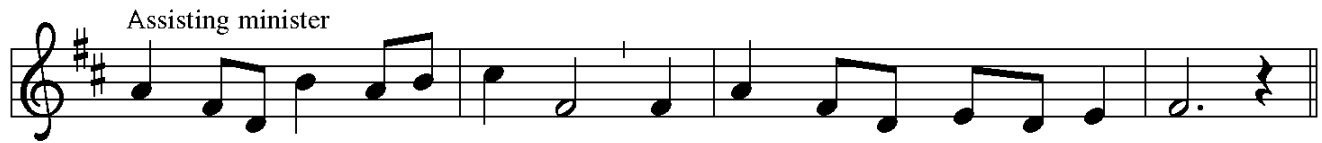

Wednesday, November 18th.

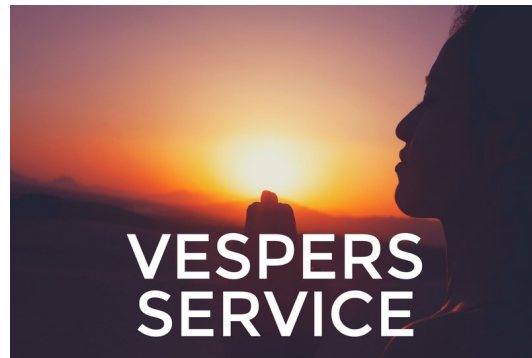
